

Footpaths Report

Following a Meeting with Brinkley Hall Farms

1. The main issue was the damage done to his wild flower conservation area beside footpath 7 by walkers failing to adhere to the paths provided, or the public footpath.
2. The secondary problem related to the use of a headland rather than the permissive path from Mill Hill down to Lower Wood
3. The initial solution is for signage of the concessionary paths to be provided. To that end:
 - a. Brinkley Hall Farms is to provide posts at the 3 sites marks on the attached map. The sites agreed yesterday are marked A, B & D. It occurs to me that a sign at point C might be useful too. (NB – flat faced posts if possible)
 - b. Weston Colville Parish Council is to attach the appropriate waymark roundels to the posts once in position. (NB I have a supply of roundels, and will undertake this task)
4. It was thought best to see if the additional signage alleviated the problem over the coming month
5. If not, a further entry and diagram requesting people stay on the marked ways would be submitted to Ms Bragg for publication in the August edition
